Dear Club Representative,

You are receiving this information because I have you listed as my first point of contact for TOPClub. If you are no longer the most appropriate contact for your Club, could you please forward this information on and let me know who should be my point of contact.

The previous update of TOPClub came in 2013 and the criteria have not changed. The intention was that each certificate would be valid for 12 months – and that it would be the responsibility of each Club to re-submit their documentation on an annual basis. I am aware that this can be an onerous task. Therefore I am issuing this March 2015 update to each Club that has registered, in an effort to aid each Club with their update.

Some of the information I have on file for each Club is still up-to-date and I have been able to find some information via Club websites, the WDCU website, the WDJCU website etc. This has been the starting point for the table of information that each Club will be receiving, individually.

Each Club will be given until Friday 17th April to return the information requested. A review will then take place. Following the review, each Club will retain their current status or will be upgraded or will be downgraded. The reviewed status will be communicated to each Club by the end of April 2015. This reviewed status will be valid until 30 September 2015 – and will be the information which will be passed on to the WDCU.
