The U15 Western Warriors season has now finished. The season ended with a great, although ultimately unsuccessful, fightback against the Caledonian Highlanders thanks to 66 from Ivan Craig (Ayr CC), 41 from Adil Ghaffar (Clydesdale CC), 3/39 from Taimoor Ahmad (Ferguslie CC) and 4/20 from skipper Shujaa Khan (Ayr CC) and a brilliant win against the Eastern Knights - led by 29* from Zain Ashraf (Clydesdale CC) and 3/27 from Ahmad, playing on his home ground too! Overall, the Warriors played 7 games and won 2 of them.

The U14 Western Warriors finished in 2nd place in the 3-team Inter-Cities Cup contested on Monday 12th and Tuesday 13th August. The first game saw the Warriors defeat the Eastern Knights (with Ferguslie CC's Taimoor Ahmad top scoring with 51 retired) and the second game saw Belfast defeat the Warriors (with Clydesdale CC's Luke Macias top scoring with 23*). Across the 2 games, William Goan (Greenock CC) with 6-2-32-3 was the leading Warriors wicket taker.

Congratulations to Adil Ghaffar (Clydesdale CC) and Shujaa Khan (Ayr CC) who had both been selected for the Scotland U15 team for the European Championships. Unfortunately injury has now ruled Adil out of the tournament.
